- *Where Dark meets Light* – St. John is a place to encounter Jesus and discover the light of hope and joy. It's a place where our deepest needs can be met by developing a deep relationship with Him.
- *Where Truth meets Grace* – Ultimately, St. John is a place where truth and grace meet. Biblical truth often confronts us and exposes our sin, but God's grace through Jesus, demands that we show unconditional acceptance for anyone regardless of what baggage they carry through the door.
